## Cycle Tourism Research Gaps / Research Suggestions:

- Improving infrastructure Central location for more Ontario information on paved shoulders, costs, best practises, strategy to justify need for paved shoulders. Kristi MacDonald, The Bike Shop in Gravenhurst

- A core set of questions to ask cyclists. There are several smaller event based questionnaires and information collected independently in Ontario. Having a core set / template based set of questions to collect a wider range of consistent data may be useful. Questions may include: How do you as an Ontario resident view the cycling sector / cycle tourism opportunities?
- Need for research that works together and all points to same end. Marlaine Koehler, Waterfront Regeneration Trust
- A tool to measure economic impact of cycle tourism and value of cycling activities in a smaller community. Barry Martin, Yours Outdoors
- A strategic planning model. We worked on a Manitoulin strategic paper One that would cover all of Ontario, vs. just local area, would be beneficial.

- Split between road riding and trail riding. Investigating the crossover. People

- Establishing useful metrics for value of cycling in Ontario. New study being commissioned by Share the Road, with Conference Board of Canada will look at some of the same metrics used in 2007 'Valuing Benefits of Cycling' study in England. - Health benefits of cycling research papers have proved to be helpful.
